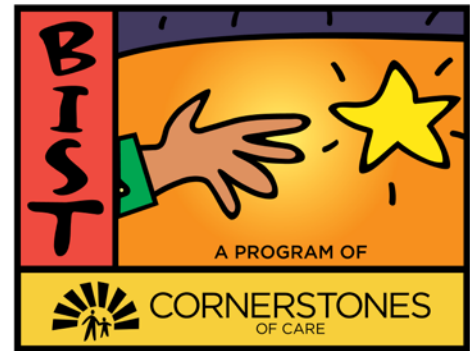


SUMMER BASIC BIST
